# Which Students Take ROTC Fulfillment Courses?

Upper level students who are not pursuing a military contract will fulfill their ROTC requirement by taking **one** pre-approved 3-credit-hour leadership-oriented class each semester during their Junior and Senior years. Each non-contracting student is responsible for successfully completing one ROTC fulfillment class in each semester in residence of the junior and senior year.

**All non-contracting students must take LDRS 371 as one of their fulfillment courses.** *Students who have taken BADM 371 for Business previously in substitution for LDRS 371 are in compliance.* Please note, you can take LDRS 371 in any semester or your upper year at The Citadel along with your 3 additional ROTC F courses.

A student's schedule (3 + LDRS 371) will dictate that they enroll and successfully pass a total of 4 fulfillment courses including LDRS 371. The first example illustrates a generic pathway for students who take LDRS 371 their junior fall, pass, and take one ROTC Fulfillment course each consecutive term. Example two shows what it would look like for a student majoring in business that is also pursuing the leadership studies minor.

## Example 1:

**Junior Fall:** LDRS 371(Required)

**Senior Fall:** ROTC Fulfillment Course

**Junior Spring:** ROTC Fulfillment Course

**Senior Spring:** ROTC Fulfillment Course

## Example 2:

*Pathway Example for Business Majors in ROTC Fulfillment also pursuing the Leadership Minor:*

**Junior Fall:** LDRS 371(Req. for graduation)

**Junior Spring :** MGMT 307/311/411 (take 2 to earn the minor)

**Senior Fall:** LDRS 433 (Req. for Minor)

**Senior Spring:** LDRS 401 (Req. for Minor)
